


BLESSINGS (vs. 1–14) If you diligently obey Me:

BACK AND FORTH GOES THE STORY 1 SAM 2:11–26




WE MUST LIVE BY GOD'S PRIORITIES

to God on his behalf.


 But they would not listen to their father, for the Lord had decided to kill them.




TO SERVE THE LORD:

WE MUST INSTILL GOD'S PRINCIPLES 1 SAM 2:26-36

- Eli and his sons earned God's cursing. 2:27-36
- "A man of God" (2:27) = a prophet
- Samuel's robe (2:19)
 vs. Eli's sons' abuse of the ephod (2:28-29)
- "Why do you kick at my sacrifice?" (2:29)





SAMUEL IS YAHWEH'S NEW SPOKESMAN 1 SAM 3:1-4:1A

- 1. Yahweh called 3 times to Samuel rather than Eli. 3:1-9
- 2. Yahweh revealed Himself to Samuel. 3:10-14
- 3. Samuel revealed Yahweh's message of cursing to Eli.3:15-18
- 4. Summary: Samuel became Yahweh's prophet. 3:19–4:1a
