Luk 11.39 — The NIV reads "give what is inside [the dish] to the poor," perhaps by analogy to the parallel rebuke of 11:39: you need to fix what is wrong in terms of greed by giving alms to the poor. This reading is probably wrong, since 11:39 looks at the need to clean the inside, not to give things from it. The main issue is not giving alms, which the Pharisees did, but how alms reflect spirituality.
