#### References to Baal Worship in Hosea

- 2.8—made silver and gold to Baal idols
- 2.13—offered sacrifices to the Baals
- 4.12—consulted a wooden idol
- 4.13—offered sacrifices on tops of mountains
- 4.13—burned incense on the hills under shaded trees
- 4.14—offered sacrifices with temple prostitutes
- 4.17—was joined to idols
- 4.19—offered sacrifices which would bring shame
- 8.4—made idols with silver and gold
- 8.5–6—the calf of Samaria, made by craftsman, rejected by God
- 8.11—multiplied altars
- 10.1—made many altars
- 10.1—made sacred pillars
- 10.2—altars and sacred pillars would be destroyed by the Lord
- 10.5—mourned over the calf at Beth-aven
- 10.6—the calf at Beth-aven was carried to Assyria
- 11.2—kept sacrificing to the Baals
- 11.2—kept burning incense to idols
- 12.11—sacrificed bulls in Gilgal
- 12.11—altars were like stone heaps
- 13.1—did wrong through Baal
- 13.2—made molten images and silver idols
- 13.2—men kissed the calves
