"In the early ages men subsisted largely upon the spontaneous productions of the earth and the spoils of the chase; owing to the uncertainty of obtaining food, fasting was often compulsory. Superstitious ignorance could easily interpret this compulsion into an expression of divine will, and so consider fasting as a religious duty. It was believed that the gods were jealous of the pleasures of men and that abstinence would propitiate their favor. As a result we find that fasting as a religious duty is almost universal." {It is worth noting that "fasting" does not occur in the Lord's Covenantal Word of the Pentateuch.}
