Throughout The Revelation the “throne sitter” has been God the Father, 4.2-3, 9; 5.1, 7, 13; 6.16; 7.10, 15; 19.4; 21.5.

Judgment is founded on two crucial truths.

Truth #1: God, who is loving, gracious, holy, righteous, true, and just, is the Creator of ALL things!

Truth #2: Man is a creature, responsible to and accountable to, his Creator, God, for everything, including our lives, belongs to and is dedicated to God!
